#### Pre K Sight Word Worksheets


Trace It - Write It - your child should trace the word on the left and write the word in the empty box provided on the right. The word is given three times for good practice.

Find and color the word - let your child find the word and color the geometric shape with a colored pencil or a crayon without crossing the borders of the given geometric shape.


Missing Letter - The memory game! Let your child fill in the blanks with missing letters to complete the word from the letter choices below.






